Small and medium enterprises are becoming increasingly important in terms of job creation globally. The purpose of the study is to examine the influence of Accounts Maintenance practices on the business performance of small and medium-scale enterprises in Sri Lanka and the study sought to establish the relationship between Accounts Maintenance and SME performance in Sri Lanka. Accounts Maintenance practices consist of proper accounting records, preparation of accounting records, and accounting records procedures. This study used small and medium size companies which are registered in CSE. Accordingly that these companies do not exceed a turnover 750Mn and the Number of employees does not exceed 300 individuals. Data was collected from annual reports for the period from 2012 to 2021. Data collected were analyzed using multiple regression analysis to examine the effect of the independent variable, Accounts maintenance practices, on the dependent variable, micro-enterprise performance (Firm value). Finally, it is expected that this study's findings would help to reflect the importance of account maintenance for SME's owners.
