audio engineers, and voice and instrumental artists. The study revealed several factors affecting

the gradual recession of music industry such as technical knowledge, lack of the sense of sound

and music, time management of sound engineers and music composers. Therefore it is

important to examine and identity remedial measures to overcome the course of gradual

recession of music industry and enhance the standards of music compositions with a Sri Lankan

identity.
