A COMPARATIVE STUDY TO RECONFIRMATION THE DISPERSION PATTERN OF THAILA BINDU PAREEKSHA WITH SELECTED PARAMETERS OF UFR

Taila bindu Pariksha of Ayurveda is pioneer of all laboratory diagnostic methods described by Yogaratnakara. It's very unique cost effective method provides diagnostic as well as prognostic information. This method is out of practice now with the rush of advance technology. In this work it have been tried to justify the practical aspect of this old technique Taila bindu Pariksha. Work is done in 60 patients who were attended to ayurvedic treatments to see the prognostic aspect of the diseases. Different aspects of Taila bindu Pariksha were studied like dispersion pattern and direction of Tailabindu. Observation includes comparative study of dispersion patterns of Taila bindu with corresponding laboratory values of UFR. A conclusion drawn after the whole work that there are some indicating feature found in Tailabindu Pariksha which provides knowledge about prognosis of the disease and identified 11 special dispersion patterns.
