

Adoption of Social Media Technologies in Academic Entrepreneurship and Its Influence on Student Entrepreneurs

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Academic institutions have started recognizing the importance of social media technologies in nurturing academic entrepreneurship. Academic leaders of university entrepreneurial ecosystem have created entrepreneurship education labs and business incubation centers to foster academic entrepreneurs by providing training in new technologies and facilitating them to utilize opportunities from social media technologies for their business startup.
