A Web Based Solution to Manage Meeting Scheduling and Minute Distribution

Meetings are a form of formal communication that give important opportunities for members to contribute their ideas and allow them to know the organization's aspirations, needs and requirements for the success of the organization. Hence, this meeting management system provides a huge advantage for all people who hold meetings due to the ability to increase the quality and effectiveness of meeting decisions by 50%.
